The Reimagining Oliver Hills Way is to create a unique one-of-a-kind space for youth, youth experiencing housing instability, and youth in transition; to increase CCC’s service footprint and extend youth services into permanent supportive and affordable housing; to foster a safe, welcoming and empowering environment for youth by better understanding their unique personal, social service, and youth-centric programming needs; to collaborate with community partners to better service Richmond area youth.

The feedback received from youth so far just sought to capture as many voices and ideas as possible. While we have accumulated a lot of data from the youth, we need to turn their ideas into something tangible both to better understand how to finance the project as well as to help youth evaluate what should and shouldn’t be prioritized. As such, we plan to hold a number of follow-up engagement events over the next few months so that our youth can help create a project that works for them. This looks like refining the site plan and building layout, developing financial models to better understand how the project will be financed, and creating opportunities for youth to tangibly understand the differences between “options”.
